Criteria for Assessment of Applicants

HPI Accompanists

- 1. Curriculum Vitae with 2 referees (1 musical)
- 2. Play two previous, contrasting, Music Festival pieces. These will be sent to you once the audition date is set.
- 3. Accompany the Director of Music using one of the two prepared pieces.
- 4. Sight read:
 - Single vocal line
 - Combination of both soprano and alto vocal lines
 - Both vocal lines with the bass line maintaining the beat
 - Piano accompaniment
 - Accompaniment plus some of the soprano/alto vocal line
- 5. Sing a part clearly with good pitch
- 6. Level of playing AMEB grade 8 standard or thereabouts
- 7. General understanding:
 - How would the applicant show support for an insecure, new or a well established choir trainer?
- 8. A Screening Unit 'Working with Children Check' (WwCC) is required before employment can commence and Responding to Risks of Harm, Abuse and Neglect Education and Care Training (RRHAN-EC) must be undertaken as soon as possible.
