Expression of Interest Host Mentors

Expressions of interest are invited for the position of Host Mentor for the 2023 Primary Schools Music Festival.

This position involves working with the Host Manager to mentor hosts throughout the audition process, rehearsals and at 2 performances during the Festival of Music concert series, as well as assisting hosts and script writers to personalize their concert scripts. A Mentor Lite option is available.

The role requires you to:

- Attend Host Mentor induction and briefing sessions led by the Host Manager.
- Work closely with the Host team to mentor students before, during and after their auditions, rehearsals and performances.
- Negotiate with the Host Manager your commitment. A full commitment involves auditions in Term 1, rehearsals after school once a fortnight from halfway through Term 1, and full day rehearsals on 2 or 3 weekends during Terms 2 and 3.
- Mentoring Lite allows a mentor to join the team at the beginning of Term 3.
- Attend offsite rehearsals during school time in Term 3.
- Attend rehearsals and performances at the Adelaide Festival Centre in weeks 8 and/or 9 of Term 3.
- Liaise with the Host Manager to ensure scripts are correct.

Host Mentors will work under the direction of the Host Manager, PSMF and the Manager, PSMF.

TRT days will be provided where necessary. Certificate of PD Hours will be provided.

Successful applicants will be required to have or be prepared to get Responding to Risks of Harm, Abuse and Neglect (RRHAN-EC) training and provide a Working with Children Check (WWCC) clearance.

Applications of one page maximum (including a brief CV) and the names of two referees (including line manager) are due Friday December 2, 2022.
