Festival of Music Concerts 2024

Not long now everyone!!!

Every member in **every concert choir** is SO important –we join together to make one large singing team!

Encourage your kids to continue working towards being a "WOW" Choir!! Check out the Choir Rubric in the Songbook..... look in the "A" column - be the best you can! Stand with hands by sides, feet hip width apart, strong!

Be prepared, know your lyrics so you can sing confidently – this is your choir 'grand final'!!

Microphones are strategically placed above various choir rows on stage so it's important for ALL rows to do their most confident and clear singing throughout the concert.

Always watch the choral conductor during a song, sing with energy and expression.

Remember ... we have cameras filming throughout the whole concert ... beaming images of the choir onto the side screens for the audience to see and for the concert download.

**Sparkle on stage through your face and stand strong in your body!!

- **Row 1** see separate information document.
- Row 1 ½ is for students with mobility issues, etc. and soloists
- Row 2 is the first row on the choir riser and very visible behind the accompanist and the grand piano. You must be very steady and focussed ALL the time – hands by sides and watching!!
- **Row 12** is the highest on the choir riser and closest to the back therefore in the audience sightline. VERY visible so be steady and focussed for the full concert; keep hands inside of the back rail once on stage. Stage manager Rohan gets grumpy if he spots kids doing the wrong thing!!
- **Choreography leaders** plan is to seat them in Row 2 or 1 ½.
- **Soloists** plan is to seat them on the ENDS of rows 2- 4 or row 1 ½.....

In the lead up to the Festival Theatre concert day and rehearsal, "just keep singing"!!
