This letter contains information regarding your child singing a solo in the Adelaide Festival of Music, in a concert that is NOT with their own school choir. They will need to attend an additional rehearsal at both Magic Millions and Festival Theatre.

MAGIC MILLIONS SOLO REHEARSAL: Students must attend the Magic Millions rehearsal for both their solo performance and their school choir performance (follow all information as provided by the choir teacher for this concert.)

For this additional solo rehearsal please arrive at least half an hour prior to their solo time on the Magic Millions song rehearsal schedule (as per link above). They may be picked up from this rehearsal once they have completed their solo, but are welcome to stay for the whole rehearsal if that arrangement is easier. Please advise the Concert Manager when you bring your child.

Country students are not required to attend the Magic Millions rehearsal but may do so.

It is a great opportunity to rehearse with the choir and the orchestra before your concert and we would love to see you!

FESTIVAL THEATRE SOLO CONCERT DAY REHEARSAL AND PERFORMANCE:

Students must attend the full Festival Theatre rehearsal for both their solo performance and their school choir performance. For concerts 1-2 please arrive at 12.15pm. Concerts 3-9 arrive at 12.45pm.

Concert 10 rehearsal arrive at 8.45am on Friday 22 September, and for the Concert on Saturday 23 September at 6pm.

As soon as you arrive please report to the Steward who will be waiting in the far west end of the foyer at John Bishop Door. (Festival Theatre map link above).

In between the rehearsal and the concert we will supervise your child while they are on their meal break.

The soloists will then meet the Conductor for their concert (Robyn Filmer or Cathy Lange) for a solo warm up. Following the warm up students will rejoin the choir in the rehearsal room until it is time to go on stage just before 7.30pm.

Concert 10 Evening concert please meet at the John Bishop Door at 6pm, to join the other soloists at 6.15pm for the warm up session.

Following the concert, please collect your child from the John Bishop Door Steward at approx. 9.30pm

At no time will a student be allowed to leave the Theatre without a supervising adult.

IF FOR SOME REASON YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND YOUR REHEARSAL, PLEASE LET US KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. There is not an opportunity for you to rehearse at a different concert rehearsal as time does not allow for more than one soloist.

PERFORMANCE FOR PARENTS: You are invited to watch the additional concert where your child is singing their solo in using your complimentary voucher. Your child will be seated in the choir for the entire concert.

TICKETS:

Ticket sales open on Monday 7 August. All tickets for the 'Festival of Music' concerts will be \$48.00 per person. Children under 3 are free on the knee. There is a Ticketek \$9.55 Service and Handling Fee (per transaction not per ticket).

- coloured choir t-shirt with
- long black pants (NO leggings, track pants or skirts please)
- black shoes or black sandshoes (closed in toes) and
- long black socks (not short ankle socks)
- Please tie hair back off the face
